

The Department of English at Dalhousie University invites applications for a full time sessional term position at the Assistant Professor level, effective 1 August 2014, subject to budgetary approval. The position will be tenable for a ten-month term in each of two years (from 1 August 2014 to 31 May 2015, and from 1 August 2015 to 31 May 2016). The successful applicant should possess a PhD in English with a specialty in Canadian Literature. Teaching experience in Academic Writing or Creative Writing would be an asset. The candidate should have a record of excellence in teaching at the undergraduate level and a promising record of scholarship in her or his field of research.
