

The Department of English at Dalhousie University invites applications for a full-time, limited-term position in Postcolonial and/or World Literatures at the rank of Assistant Professor. The position will be tenable for a ten-month term (1 August 2018 to 31 May 2019). Applicants should have a Ph.D. by the date of appointment. They should also have a record of excellence in teaching at the undergraduate level and a promising record of scholarship in some aspect of Postcolonial and/or World Literatures. Teaching experience in Academic Writing is an asset. The position is subject to budgetary approval.

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority. Dalhousie University is committed to fostering a collegial culture grounded in diversity and inclusiveness. The University encourages applications from Aboriginal people, persons with a disability, racially visible persons, women, persons of minority sexual orientations and gender identities, and all candidates who would contribute to the diversity of our community.

Applications will be accepted until 1 May, 2018 and must include the following: a letter of application addressed to Dr. Carrie Dawson, Chair of the Search Committee; a CV; a writing sample (max. 25 pp.); a teaching dossier addressing teaching effectiveness and teaching interests; and a completed Self-Identification Questionnaire (available at [www.dal.ca/becounted/selfid](http://www.dal.ca/becounted/selfid)).

Applicants must have three referees forward signed and scanned letters of reference to ENGLJOBS@dal.ca by 1 May, 2018.
