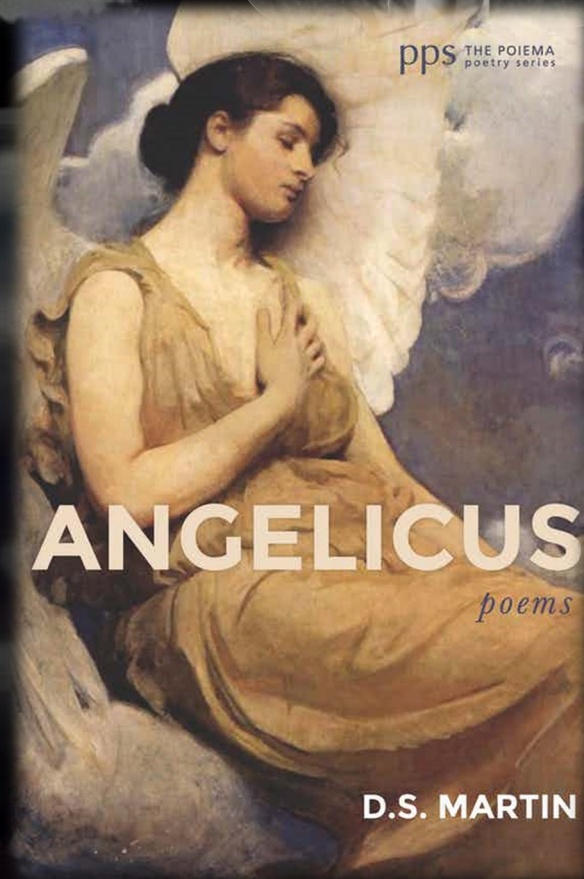

D. S. Martin (dsmartin.ca) is a Canadian poet, Series Editor for the Poiema Poetry Series, and Poet-in-Residence at McMaster Divinity College. His 2021 collection, *Angelicus*, is available from Cascade Books! Previous collections include *Amper-sand* (2018), *Conspiracy of Light: Poems Inspired by the Legacy of C. S. Lewis* (2013), *Poeima* (2008), and the chapbook *So the Moon Would Not Be Swallowed* (Rubicon, 2007). Edited anthologies include *In a Strange Land* (2019), *The Turning Aside: The Kingdom Poets Book of Contemporary Christian Poetry* (2016) and *Adam, Eve, & the Riders of the Apocalypse* (2017). D. S. Martin has an active online presence through his blogs *Kingdom Poets*, and through the web journal *Poems for Ephesians*, inspired by the apostolic letters. This year, 19 of his poems, inspired by John Donne's 19 Holy Sonnets, will be featured at *Reformed Journal* over the 19 months from January 2023 to July 2024, on the 4th Tuesday of every month.
